We take a prideful approach with each step of the process. We are here to make sure the memorial for your loved one as special as they were.


SIZES & SHAPES **ALLOWED**



The following information will help us to determine what is allowed on your plot.





All sandblasted designs & lettering are included with your monument purchase from Domenick DeNigris Monuments and Mausoleums. We do not charge per character or per design element.













ETCHINGS

Here is an easy to follow list of the steps required in this process before we can deliver and set a monument at the cemetery.

Order is placed. A computer drawing will be provided to the family for approval. This computer drawing will show you all of the sizes, the lettering, the art work, shapes 02 etc...It is a comprehensive computer drawing of what is to come and how the monument will look with all of the lettering and design elements. Once we receive approval from the family on the computer drawing, we can then apply to the cemetery. This usually involves sending a permit/ 03 foundation check along with the application and computer drawing which has been approved by the family. We now wait for approval from the cemetery so that our factory can begin to manufacture 04 the monument. Once we receive the cemetery approval, we can then begin to work on fabrication of the monument.

The next step is awaiting a notice from the cemetery which let's us know the foundation is in and we can now deliver and set the monument at the cemetery.
